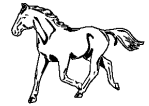

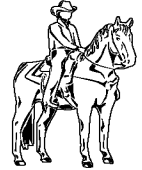

**Note:** One of our club members wanted to share this to make sure no one else makes the same mistake!

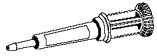
*Have you heard that it's OK to give Horse Wormer (Ivermectrin) to your cats and dogs?*

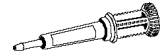
### **TRAIL RIDE NOTES:**
