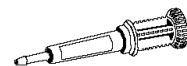
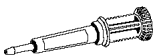

HELP IS AT HAND

The Equestrian Land Conservation Resource (ELCR) offers help regarding preserving and maintaining land for keeping, enjoying, and competing all types horses. Not only is their staff and network available via telephone, email, and fax, but the website (www.elcr.org) is packed with information on a variety of topics and you may order the help tools in the ELCR Store section. The help library of help tools has expanded to include:

LOCAL PLANNING AND ZONING PRACTICES RELATED TO EQUESTRIAN FACILITIES

The *Zoning* booklet was developed because of horse owner requests. It is intended to provide insight into zoning ordinances of land intended for keeping horses, giving riding lessons, hosting rodeos, horse shows, or eventing. The booklet discusses five valuable areas including zoning, definitions of allowed use, design, rezoning, and other considerations. If you are planning to purchase or expand an equestrian facility, this booklet may help you avoid some common pitfalls.

EQUESTRIAN ECONOMIC IMPACT ANALYSIS: HOW YOUR COMMUNITY BENEFITS

This booklet is intended to provide a basic understanding of the economic impact horses and horse owners have on a community and is directed to public officials and others who do not understand the value of keeping their communities horse friendly. The 7.1 million horse owners nationally contribute over \$100 billion to the gross national product. Where does it fit into your community's economy?

GETTING ORGANIZED: CREATING AN EQUESTRIAN TRAILS ORGANIZATION

This manual begins with the premise that land and equestrian trails must be preserved. It provides step-by-step information for working with an existing group or, if necessary, for creating a new organization. It further explains how to gather people and resources, create goals and by-laws, prepare and hold an initial meeting and establish regular meeting formats. An appendix with sample forms and additional resources and reading lists are included for more detailed information.

EQUESTRIAN LAND PROTECTION GUIDE

This manual is a step-by-step action plan for land protection that is written specifically for horse people. It offers practical suggestions for developing the appropriate team to make a conservation project possible, developing a manageable plan, maximizing the resources (both financial and manpower), negotiating various types of agreements, building landowner relations, and planning for the future to keep what has been achieved.

IN THEIR SHOES

This video presents enjoying a trail from the viewpoint of a horseback rider, hiker, and biker – with all their roles scrambled. The three trail users switch modes and obtain a much different perspective and appreciation for the other trail users. Originally produced by the Arizona State Committee on Trails, this 11-minute video provides a good discussion opening piece for meetings on shared or multi use trails and is available through ELCR.

EASEMENT GUIDE FOR EQUESTRIAN USE

If an easement is appropriate for your land, this manual will help you include the necessary legal language to permanently keep your land open for the horse use you want to maintain. The manual provides language relating to equestrian use that ELCR has extracted from its easement collection. Landowners may find language that expresses their intent for preservation of equestrian use. Attorneys or land use specialists may discover new ways to protect equestrian use in tandem with other conservation values. ELCR assumes that anyone using this manual as a guide for drafting an easement is relying on an attorney for advice as to the meaning and legal effect of the language.

RECREATIONAL USE STATUTES AND THE PRIVATE LAND OWNER

Commonly known as “recreational use statutes”, these brochures contain a brief description of responsibilities for both the land owner and the recreational user regarding limited liability for land owners who allow recreational use on their property. These brochures provide state-specific law and how to access it via the Internet. When riders request permission to ride in a new place, this brochure may be helpful in alleviating some of the land owner's risk and liability fears. This brochure is available for download on the website for free.
