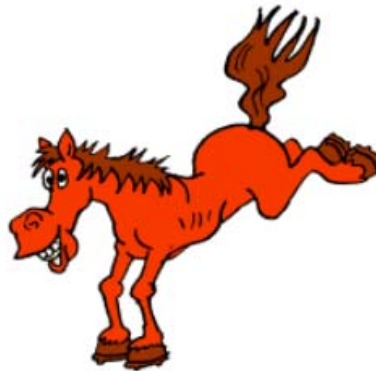

WARNING TO ALL HORSE OWNERS

There has been a recent increase in cases of POTOMAC HORSE FEVER. The St. Louis Post Dispatch had an article in Tuesday, August 19, 2008 warning of the recent outbreak. Symptoms include fever, lethargy and lack of appetite. Sickened horses develop a fever, depressed or sad look and go off their feed. They can develop severe diarrhea, colic, laminitis (a hoof infection) and blood poisoning.

The disease is not contagious from horse to horse or to other animals. Horses can develop the illness from unintentionally ingesting infected flies, snails or larvae that end up in the horses water supply. Horses in the area should be vaccinated every 3 months for potomac horse fever, typically horses are vaccinated once every spring.

About half of the infected horses have died from this sickness, immediate and aggressive treatment with a certain antibiotic can result in a horse quickly recovering.
