PARADES: We will be riding in the O'Fallon Christmas parade on December 3rd, 2005 at 6:00pm details will be forthcoming.

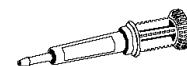
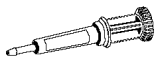
Rain Dates are as follows: October 1st will be for the August 13th Pleasure Show; and October 8th will be for the August 27th Game Show.

If you know anyone who can foster/rescue these loving animals, or any other rescue group who are willing to help out - please contact the Humane Society of West Louisiana! **It is likely that we will be getting more and more calls** from owners who are having to make the choice of surrendering their pets, but we just do not have the room for them!
